## **491. State Team Rules And Guidelines**

### **491.1. Objectives**

- 491.1.1. The objective of the State Team Rules And Guidelines is to provide the foundation for the best team possible to be sent to the National Championships.
- 491.1.2. To provide a clear and concise set of rules to ensure the selection of the team is well communicated, understood and accepted.
- 491.1.3. To ensure the selection of the teams is done without subjectivity.
- 491.1.4. To provide incentives to the State Team thereby ensuring Victoria is seen as the premier State for archery.

### **491.2. Responsibilities**

- 491.2.1. The State Senior Team shall be selected and monitored by the Sport Development Officer with final approval by the Board.
- 491.2.2. The State Youth Team shall be selected and monitored by the Youth Development Officer, in conjunction with the Sport Development Officer, with final approval by the Board.

### **491.3. Team Composition**

- 491.3.1. The Senior Compound Team shall consist of 4 males and 4 females which shall challenge for the National Compound Teams Trophy.
- 491.3.2. The Senior Recurve Team shall consist of 4 males and 4 females which shall challenge for the National Recurve Teams Trophy.
- 491.3.3. In any of the above a minimum of 6 archers (3 male and 3 female) may comprise a team. If less than 6 archers (3 male and 3 female) qualify then a team shall not be selected.
- 491.3.4. Archery Victoria shall also send archers to compete in the Barebow Recurve competitions. This team shall consist of no more than 4 males and 4 females.

## **491. State Team Rules And Guidelines**

### **491.4. Selection Criteria**

- 491.4.1. Archers must have full membership of Archery Victoria.
- 491.4.2. Archers must apply to be part of the following year's State Team no later than the 30th of June each year.
- 491.4.3. Freestyle archers must compete in 4 target tournaments and 2 field tournaments between the 1st of July and the 30th of November and achieve the required rating as listed in the table at 491.4.12.
- 491.4.4. The selection of the State Team (freestyle) shall be based on the required rating being achieved in 6 events. If more than 4 archers are eligible for the State Team in any Division then a shoot-off shall be conducted concurrently with the State Target Championships.
- 491.4.5. Barebow recurve archers must compete in 4 field tournaments between the 1st of July and the 30th of November and achieve the required rating as listed in the table at 491.4.12.
- 491.4.6. The selection of the State Team (barebow) shall be based on the required rating being achieved in 4 events. If more than 4 archers are eligible for the State Team in any Division then a shoot-off shall be held concurrently with a marked Field Grand Prix or a trial to be arranged in the following January.

## 491. State Team Rules And Guidelines

### 491.4. Selection Criteria (continued)

- 491.4.7. The announcement of the State Team shall be made at the State Target Championships (where practicable).
- 491.4.8. The presentation to the State Team of their attire shall be made at the State Short Range Championships (where practicable).
- 491.4.9. The members of the State Team shall remain members of the team until the conclusion of the next State Target Championships.
- 491.4.10. Members of the Senior State Team must shoot all the target and field events at the Nationals.
- 491.4.11. Members of the Youth State Team must shoot all the target, field and clout events at the Nationals.
- 491.4.12. The ratings table is set by Archery Australia and is subject to change without notice.

#### **491. State Team Rules And Guidelines**

##### **491.5. The Rewards - Senior**

- 491.5.1. Each member of the Senior State Team shall receive 2 short sleeve shooting shirts and 1 tracksuit.
- 491.5.2. Archers holding shirts or tracksuits from previous teams may apply for the cash equivalent being no more than \$150.
- 491.5.3. Archers holding clothing from previous years shall receive a patch showing the year of participation.
- 491.5.4. Upon successful application to the State Squad the archer may purchase an Archery Victoria State Squad Short Sleeve T-shirt.

##### **491.6. The Rewards - Youth**

- 491.6.1. Each member of the Youth State Team shall receive 2 short sleeve shooting shirts and 1 tracksuit.
- 491.6.2. Archers holding shirts or tracksuits from previous teams may apply for the cash equivalent being no more than \$150.
- 491.6.3. Archers holding clothing from previous years shall receive a patch showing the year of participation.
- 491.6.4. Upon successful application to the State Squad the archer may purchase an Archery Victoria State Squad Short Sleeve T-shirt.
